**Subject: Human Rights Council second intersessional meeting for dialogue and cooperation on Human Rights and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (3 December 2019)**

Pursuant to resolution 37/24, adopted on 23 March 2018, the second of the two Human Rights Council intersessional meetings for dialogue and cooperation on human rights and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development will be held on Tuesday, 3 December 2019, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. in Room XX at the Palais des Nations.

This meeting will build on the conclusions of the first intersessional meeting and will contribute to illustrating concretely the synergies and linkages between human rights and the SDGs. Inspired by the [political declaration of the Sustainable Development Goals Summit](#), the second intersessional meeting will focus on the broad theme “Decade of Action and Delivery of the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda”.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the meeting and invite the participation of your organisation in connection with its work to facilitate the implementation of the 2030 Agenda.

The intersessional meeting is intended to share and exchange good practices, methodologies, achievements, challenges and lessons learned in how integrated approaches to implementing the SDGs and realizing human rights contribute to the fulfillment of the 2030 Agenda and in how to best make the next decade one of action and delivery, in particular at field level on the ground.
