

Mr. President OR Vice-President, honorable head and members of the Commission, distinguished colleagues!

I express my gratitude for the work of the Commission, for its conclusions and recommendations.

The world has to know about crimes committed by Russian military. Many of them are **beyond** human.

Some of the crimes require **more** attention.

Particularly, the cases of **unlawful confinement and torturing of Ukrainian children** and their **forcible displacement** to the Russian Federation.

Such actions are not simple violations. **They are genocidal** according to Article 2 of the UN Genocide Convention and **must be legally qualified and investigated**.

Also, apparent summary execution of **unarmed** Ukrainian soldier **after the words** 'Glory to Ukraine' **must get** its proper assessment.

Also, cruel torture applied to Ukrainian prisoners of war **and** their mass execution **in Olenivka**, is another attempt **to hide** the results of such torture.

I would ask Commission of Inquiry to investigate the case of Olenivka under its mandate as soon as the access to that area is possible, **since** the separate special UN Commission on Olenivka **failed**.

I call on the Commission to strengthen its work **on the ground** to document all the crimes and let me assure you of **my full assistance** to the Commission at all times.
